The PG&E Oroville project team provides this update of cleanup work at the former Oroville manufactured gas plant (MGP) located at the corner of Huntoon and Montgomery streets in downtown Oroville. Work Completed 8/16/18 to 8/22/18

- Delivery of long-reach excavator, loader, job site trailers, trench plates and rumble racks
- Potholing and trenching activities
- Excavated sidewalk and planter area
- Placed asphalt for temporary truck driveway
- Removal of light post which will be saved for reinstallation at the end of the cleanup project
- Conducted background air sampling

Work Planned for Upcoming Week

- Continue trenching and excavation activities
- Remove six loads per day of excavated soil

Air Monitoring

- Air monitoring is conducted during work activities. The results support that air quality established by the regulatory agencies to protect the surrounding community is not being impacted by our activities.

Work Hours

- 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday

Anticipated Impacts

- There will be some noise and truck traffic associated with construction activities

Site Security

- Access gates are closed, and on-site security patrols are conducted during non-working hours
